The **Dust Doctoral Network (Dust-DN)** aims to advance our understanding of atmospheric dust processes and microphysics, identify the signatures of source regions, assess the socio-economic impacts of dust transport, and improve the quantification of dust's role in the climate system.

We are pleased to announce the **European Workshop on Atmospheric Dust**, which will take place in **Cyprus (venue to be confirmed)** from **20 to 22 April 2026**.

The workshop will serve as a **forum for the scientific community** to discuss current advances in dust research, exchange ideas, and strengthen collaborations across Europe. It will also "photograph" the present state of dust science in Europe by showcasing results from the Dust-DN network and beyond.

Due to logistical constraints, participation will be limited to approximately **100 attendees**. Priority will be given to **Dust-DN partners and presenting authors**.
